Class of Use:

A Horses at Grass only

B All activities listed in A above, Heavy Horses, Stallions at Stud, Hacking, Showing, Gymkhana, Driving (excluding cross country and trials), Dressage (up to and including elementary), Pony Club Activities, Jumping up to 95cms in the following: Pony Club, Riding Club, Hunter Trials, Unaffiliated Showjumping

C All activities listed in A and B above, Dressage (medium to advanced), Hunting, Long Distance Riding (up to 25 miles), Showjumping under British Showjumping Rules, Unaffiliated and Affiliated British Eventing (up to and including intermediate), Jumping over 1 metre in the following: Pony Club, Riding Club, Hunter Trials, Unaffiliated Showjumping

D All activities listed in A, B and C above, Dressage (Prix St George to Grand Prix), Team Chasing, Polo, Advanced British Eventing

This list is not exhaustive. If you partake in any other activities not listed above or you are unsure which class of use you should be declaring, please consult your broker.

Death:

We will pay the sum insured or market value of your horse, whichever is less in the event of the death or destruction on humane grounds resulting from accidental injury, illness or disease. We will also pay up to a maximum of £200 for disposal costs.

Theft or Mysterious Disappearance:

We will pay the sum insured or market value whichever is less if your horse is stolen or mysteriously disappears. We will also pay up to £200 towards the cost of advertising

Vets Fees:

Covers your horse for veterinary surgeon fees and medication in the event of accident, illness or disease

Cover 1: £3,000 per period of insurance. Excess £150 for each and every claim

Cover 2: £5,000 per period of insurance. Excess £150 for each and every claim

Cover 3: £5,000 per incident. £12,500 per period of insurance. Excess £195 for each and every claim

Cover 4: £5,000 per incident. £12,500 per period of insurance. Excess £195 or 15% whichever is greater for each and every claim

Colic Extension

Covers your horse for additional veterinary surgeon fees and medication in the event of colic surgery only. Extension covers a further £2,500 subject to an additional premium.

Permanent Loss of Use:

Available for horses aged 3 to 15 years

Available on class of use B to D only

We will pay 75% of your horse's sum insured or market value, whichever is less if the insured horse becomes permanently and totally incapacitated as a result of accident, illness or disease. We will pay 60% of your horse's sum insured or market value whichever is less in the event of an accident, illness or disease whereby your horse can still be used for breeding or hacking purposes. This section is only valid through suitable veterinary advice and full evidence. Cover will not be operative for the first 30 days of cover commencing.

Public Liability

£500,000, £1,000,000 or £2,000,000. This section is fully excluded whilst ever your horse is being used in any riding establishment. A £250 excess is applicable for any third party property damage.

Personal Accident to Rider(s)

Covers riders for death, loss of limbs, loss of sight, deafness and disablement up to a maximum of £20,000. Benefit for riders under the age of 16 will be reduced by 50%. Dental costs are also included up to a maximum of £1,000

This section is fully excluded whilst the horse is being used in any riding establishment. Cover is not available for riders under the age of 5 years and over the age of 75 years.

Saddlery and Tack

We will pay for accidental loss, damage and theft by means of violent entry to or exit from a securely locked building. Lock must consist of five lever mortice deadlock, a deadlocking rim latch or a key operated cylinder deadlock and all accessible windows are to be secured with key operated window locks. This section is subject to a £150 excess.

Trailers and Horse Drawn Vehicles

We will pay the sum insured, market value or cost of repairs whichever is less in the event of theft or accidental damage of any insured trailer or horse drawn vehicle. This section is subject to a £150 excess and cover for theft is excluded unless precautions have been taken to secure the trailer or vehicle whilst it is not in use.

Equi-Sure Veteran

A benefit for horses aged 18 or over with values from £500 to £2,000 only (higher values on referral)

Class of use A and B (class C and D use on referral only).

Death

We will pay the sum insured or market value of your horse, whichever is less in the event of the death or destruction on humane grounds resulting from accidental injury amounting to bone fractures and visible external wounds only.

Vets Fees

Covers your horse for veterinary surgeon fees and medication in the event of bone fractures and visible external wounds only

Cover: £2,000 per period of insurance. Excess £150 for each and every claim

Permanent Loss of Use is not available. All other benefits under Equi-Sure Veteran remain unaltered.

In deciding to accept this insurance and in setting the terms and premium, **we** have relied on the information **you** have given us. **You** must take care when answering any questions **we** ask by ensuring that all information provided is accurate and complete.

If **we** establish that **you** deliberately or recklessly provided us with false or misleading information **we** will treat this insurance as if it never existed and decline all claims.

If **we** establish that **you** carelessly provided us with incorrect or incomplete information that **we** have relied upon in accepting this insurance and setting its terms and premium **we** may:

- treat this insurance as if it had never existed and refuse to pay all claims and return the premium paid. **We** will only do this if **we** provided **you** with insurance cover which **we** would not otherwise have offered;
- amend the terms of **your** insurance. **We** may apply these amended terms as if they were already in place if a claim has been adversely impacted by **your** carelessness
- charge you more premium for **your** insurance or reduce the amount **we** pay on a claim in the proportion the premium you have paid bears to the premium **we** would have charged you; or
- cancel **your** insurance in accordance with the "Cancelling this insurance" section on Page 7.

We or **your** broker will write to you if **we**:

- intend to treat this insurance as if it never existed; or
- need to amend the terms of **your** insurance; or
- require **you** to pay more premium for **your** insurance.

Notifying us of any changes

You must notify **your** broker as soon as practicable if **you** become aware of any changes in the information **you** have provided to us which happens before or during any period of insurance. All notifications must be made in writing, by email, or by telephone.

Changes to the information **you** have provided could result in **you** having to pay an additional premium or us amending the terms of **your** insurance.



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
